

Hear him

God gave his word, to the Egyptians and their king.

Exodus 9:18-20

20 He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle run into the houses:

The word, "feared" in hebrew is - Yare' (verb); meaning: show reverence.

And the English word Revere, means: feel deep respect or admiration for (someone or something).

He that revered *God's word*.

Jesus is the word of God, John 1:1, John 1:14 ... the word became flesh..., Luke 1:35

This whole event is symbolic of the end times when God sent his son, Jesus & said (Mark 9:7).

Exodus 9:20-23

23 And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and **the LORD sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground;** and the LORD rained hail upon the land of Egypt.

You know "Hail", is **mvua ya mawe**.

How do iceball & fire cowork? (Mvua ya mawe na moto vinafanyikaJe vyote kwa wakati mmoja?)

Psalms 148:1-8 (but moses clarifies that every element {element nikama upepo, maji, udongo...} hears God's word & performs his desire. (they hear Jesus, because Jesus is Gods word)

Proof, John 1:3, Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14, 20, 24, 26,

Genesis 1:28. (there we Go.)

God even created sex, you better believe it: if God didn't say, "be fruitful & multiply." There would be no sex. But only one condition (Genesis 2:24 ...his wife...).

You know it's not Just a matter of telling people not to sin, how not to sin?

Remember the Samaritan woman?

John 4:7-18
