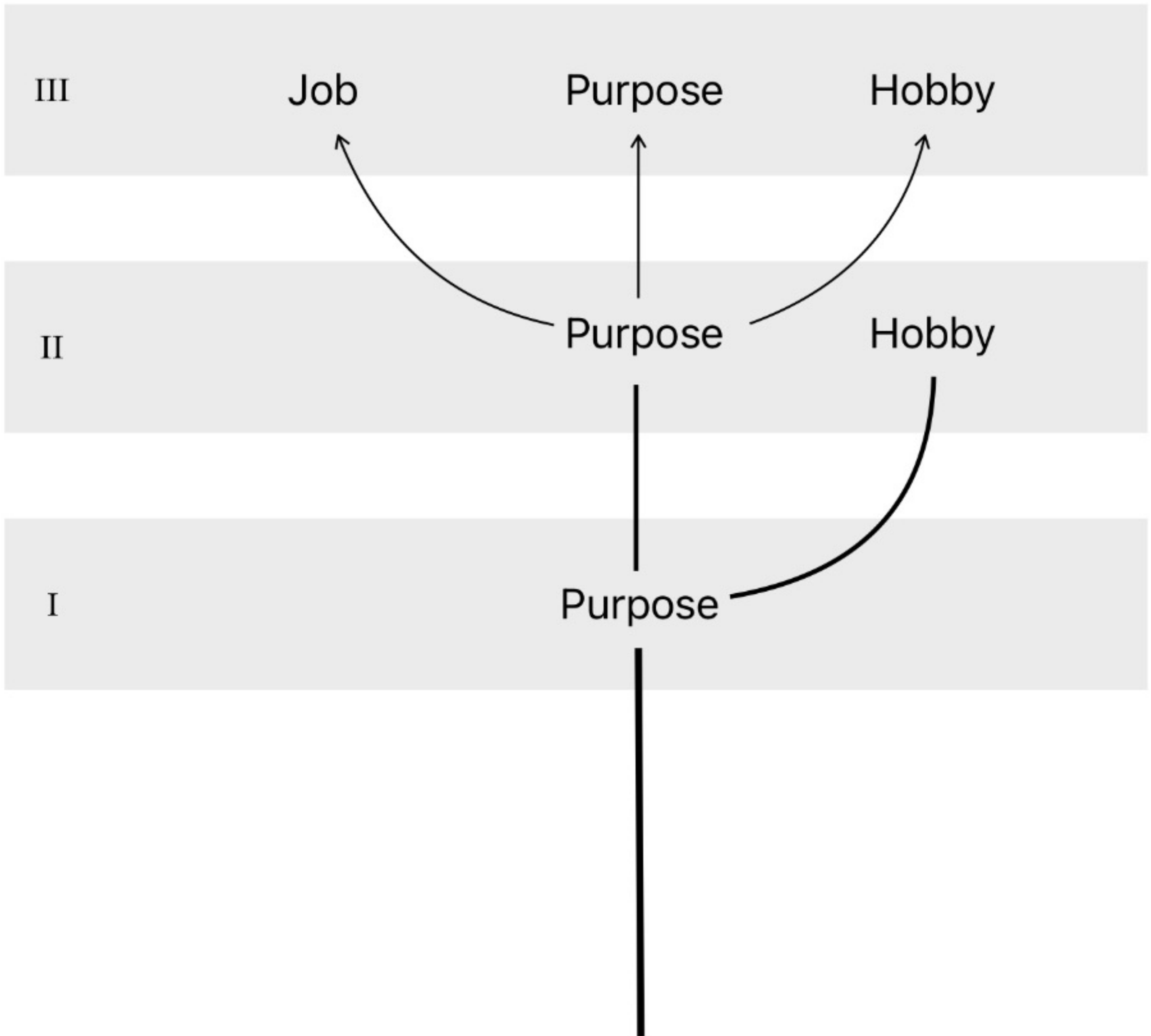


LEVEL I

1 Kings 3:9 Give therefore your servant an
understanding heart (the word is not accurate
it should read) Give therefore your servant a
hearing heart...

Wisdom from God is 100% connected to hearing wiser men filled with the spirit of God.

Apostle paul knew who he was (

Romans 1:1

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, **called to be an apostle**, separated unto the gospel of God,

Our purpose comes from God the father, not our desire!

But if God gives you a purpose: you will find out the more you pray for him to tell you what it is, he might show you bit by bit.

You know we think of purpose as something extra to do, but to God it is the most central thing. That's why on the image in page 1, purpose is central & the first thing a child should ask God to tell him.

Ephesians 1

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of his calling...

This is the eyes of your spirit (You are a spirit, you have a soul, and all of these are contained in a container called the body).

Pray that God the father, may shed light towards the eyes of your spirit, God does this **through preaching** (That's how he speaks to you, by you listen to anointed preaching).

Iliujue uito wa mungu (that you may know the calling of God in your life), not every body is called to preach, or to pray for others, Just ask God what **he made you** for.

It sound so serious, 😊 uito, but there's no way to sugar coat it so 😂 it's enjoyable I tell you.

You think you need to pray to God to give you desire to do his purpose, you need him to help you balance: because it's something you were made to do (you can find yourself not doing other stuff).
