## Mark 12

- 5 And again he sent another; and him they killed, and many others; beating some, and killing some.
- 6 Having yet therefore one son, his wellbeloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will reverence my son.

Jesus here is talking about himself, the only son of God (Before the cross: now all born again christians are sons of God John 1:12). (Matthew 3:13-17) (this event takes place in mark 1:10) so after Abba said to him (Jesus), "you are my beloved son, I Am well pleased with you."

Because this is mark 1 Jesus after hearing God's voice from heaven, beieved he is (God) the father's well beloved. in mark 12 on the image up above Jesus declares the same thing about himself.

Mark 12:6 Having yet therefore one son, <u>his</u> wellbeloved,
