

HOW TO DEAL WITH ENEMIES, IN GRACE.

Proverbs 25:21-22

Apostle Paul says in his letter to the church
Romans 12:14 Bless those who persecute you
[who cause you harm or hardship]; pray that
God will bless them, and do not curse them.

And Jesus says in Matthew
Matthew 5:44 ...I (Jesus) say unto you, Love your
enemies, bless them that curse you...

A curse is a negative decree someone makes
against your life, that can work if supported by
demonic powers/witch craft (Numbers 22:2,
22:5-6. Israelites are a symbol of Christians, and
the enemies that Christians face.)

Or a curse can work if it is supported by God's
power (Deuteronomy 11:26, 30:19, see a man of
God can speak a curse, Proverbs 18:21.)

"Laana ni matamshi ambayo mtu hutamka
kinyume na maisha yako, yanayoweza kufanya
kazi endapo yatatiwa nguvu na nguvu za
kichawi (Hesabu 22:2, 22:5-6), au mungu
(Kumbukumbu la torati 11:26, 30:19, Mithali
18:21.)"

But Jesus says, "bless them that curse you."
Why? Because when you bless them, your
enemies get a chance to change: to see God's
goodness through you (Matthew 5:46.)

And If your enemies chooses not to change,
then God your Father which is in heaven, will
punish your enemy, according as he promised
in his word

Proverbs 11:21

No matter what, I shall not leave a wicked
person without punishment.

"Hata iweje, sita muacha mtu muovu bila
kumuathibu."

Proverbs 11:19 He that does things righteously
will live, but anyone who insists on doing evil
will die.

Even if God said these words, it is not our
responsibility to accelerate these words, as
Jesus demonstrated in: Matthew 12:14-15, 26:14-
16, 47-51, John 18:10, and Luke 22:50-51 (Jesus
healed the enemy that came to capture him to
send him to the cross.)

Hebrews 10

³⁰ For we know the One who has said, **Vengeance belongs to Me, I will repay,** and again, **The Lord will judge His people.** ³¹ It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God!

Let them that refuse to change fall into the hands of the Living God (Punishment.)

Waebrania 10:30-31.

Acha wanaokataa kubadilika waangukie mikononi mwa bwana (Adhabu.)

But pray to God, that he protect you, and your loved ones. Also remind God the promises he made in his word, like (Speak the words in Psalms 121:1-8 and personalize them, these promises are from God to me.)

(Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is made to harm you shall work against you. Father I thank you that as your word says, the enemies weapons shall not work against me, in Jesus name.)

There is a reason why every Good promise, that God gave even to the Israelites in the old testament is your as well.

Because all the promises of God function as long as you are in Jesus, as long as you are a child of God.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ (meaning they can be received by those who are in Jesus christ.)
