The Gift of Knowledge

(John 14:26, Isaiah 54:13, and 2 Peter 1:2) When we combine these scriptures we get...

"The Holy spirit...shall teach you all things. You...shall be taught...and shall have **great peace**.

Peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge."

Be taught by the holy spirit, and your peace shall multiply, but the Holy Spirit teaches us through Knowledge (through <u>Daath</u> in hebrew.)

What is Daath?

Lets see it in practice, (Proverbs 7:6-14 ...she said unto him, I have peace offerings with me...)

how do you think King Solomon knew, what the woman in the streets was telling the boy? from his house window (Proverbs 7:6)? I believe Solomon moved closer to investigate

Proverbs 13:16 Every prudent person acts with knowledge, But a fool displays foolishness.

"king Solomon acted with knowledge."

The word knowlegde - **Daath** in Hebrew, is from the Hebrew verb, **Yada**, which means - percieve, take notice, and investigate (inquire or observe), and therefore clearly understand something.

That's why I wonder, no one has a question 😂.

Knowledge comes through asking God, to fill you with **his spirit in knowledge**, and using the spirit to investigate, observe and learn things.

Bezaleel is an Israelite, who God appointed to make the Ark of the covenant.

the Ark of the covenant was a box made up of incorruptible wood, and plated with Gold.

It was the most essential component of the temple of God during the wilderness journey of the Israelites, when they left Egypt (Acts 13:17.)

Exodus 31:1-5

...I (God) have called Bezaleel...and have filled him with my spirit...in knowledge (in hebrew, "Daath")

The LORD gave him his specific spirit so that he can perceive (see) things that others can't, take notice (become aware) of details, and investigate matters, more than a normal human can; After that he had interest in investigating, asking, learning how to do carvings, and was able to do it in the best way. God gave him the interest to search out, in deep (That ability is spiritual.)

So how do we Get it?

Pray to God, to give you his spirit in knowledge.

Matthew 7:9-11 (your heavenly Father will give you good gifts if you ask him.)

Don't forget to use, (in Jesus name at the end.)

John 16:23 ...Whatsoever you shall ask the Father (God the father) in my name, he will give it...

Matthew 7:8

For every one that asks receives...

John 14:26

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit — the Father will send Him in My name — will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you.

the Holy Spirit teaches us, through listening to preachings, or reading the bible (because through those two, you hear the knowlegde of God, and of Jesus.) allow him to teach you.

John 16:33 ... I have spoken to you, so that you may be peaceful...

Do you want peace? Listen to the things Jesus is speaking, through preachings, or worship songs.
