

How Much Faith?

Several months ago I read a testimony on a book, about a guy who had HIV, and this guy prayed to God for months, and God healed him finally. (So this guy prayed and went to do a check up, many times 🙄, until the last time when he went and was proven negative. So I asked God, why did you take so long to heal him?

As he said to Abraham in Genesis 18
Verse 9 to 14.

me?"

The answer, no.

And God himself proved this to us, in
the stories of the bible, in Exodus when
he divided the red sea, in the time of
Joshua when Joshua prayed and God
stopped the earth from revolving...

...so that his people can enjoy day light during their battle with the enemies.

(You can look for all these stories at your own time and read them. Exodus 14:13-30, Exodus 15:1-2, and Joshua 10:12-14.)

The matter is, how much faith do you have? Because the only pipe, or passage way for Gods power from heaven to earth is a child of Gods faith, and prayer.

all things are possible when you pray with a heart full of faith (Mark 9:23.)

So if you want God to do something crazy that is not normal, increase your faith.

Romans 10:17 says, "Faith comes by hearing the word of God."

Romans 10:14 ...how shall they hear without a preacher?

May the Holy spirit lead you to a preacher that he has filled with that level of faith, then listen to the preaching of faith, and pray to God until you see the result! That's how you know your faith has reached the size.

Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that brings good new

(a preacher), that publishes peace...

"Isaya 52:7 Jinsi ilivyo mizuri juu ya milima Miguu yake aletaye habari njema (mhubiri), Yeye aitangazaye amani..."

Don't go to preachers that don't have beautiful feet, it's a poetic language to mean preachers that live a blameless life (Titus 1:7)

"Usiende kwa wahubiri ambao miguu yao sio mizuri, ni lugha ya picha inayo maanisha wanaoishi maisha matakatifu (Tito 1:7)"
